Objective

Students will understand that the foundation of the Gospel of Jesus is solid and will commit to live according to God's purpose without shame.

Key Scripture

2 Timothy 1:8

Therefore, do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God.

Key Thought

An unwavering foundation leads to unwavering faith.

Lesson Summary

Tonight's lesson was the first in a four-part series called "*Unwavering: Steadfast Faith for an Ever-Changing World.*" It is a study from the New Testament Book of 2 Timothy. In this series, the students will be learning about the unwavering life of Paul and his description of how a Christian should live to the end.

This first lesson focused on the foundation of what we believe and how that should affect the way we live. When your foundation is unwavering, you can live in confidence with unwavering faith. Those who believe in Jesus have an unwavering foundation. God has given us a spirit of power, of love, and of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7). We don't have to be ashamed of Jesus or worried if what He says is true; our foundation is secure.

As a way to demonstrate their unwavering faith, we challenged the students to come up with a creative way to express that faith publicly. Ask your student how he/she plans to express his or her faith. If you have an unwavering faith in Jesus, consider how you might express that faith this week as well.
