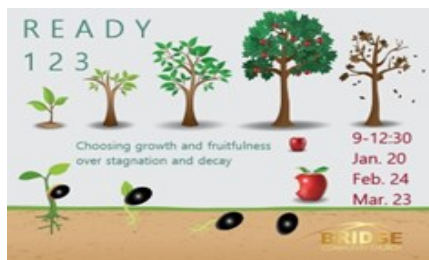
Our Annual Business Meeting is Wednesday January 28th at 7pm in the Sanctuary. All committee chairs need to have reports into the office by Thursday January 15th.
